C+S have been awarded with the Special Prize of the Gold Medal of Italian Architecture for the urban adaptor in Piazzale Roma in Venice, with the In/Opera Award, the Sfide 2009 Award of the Italian Ministry of Environment and the Gold Medal of Italian Architecture for Education for outstanding school building design. C+S work is published internationally in architecture books and magazines and has been exhibited in a personal exhibition at the MIT in Boston, in Venice (8th and 12th, 13th and 14th Biennale of Architecture and 50th Art Biennale), Milan (at the Triennale), Paris (Cité de l'Architecture et du Patrimoine), London (RIBA), Barcellona (COAC), Vienna (Architektzentrum) and Leuven (M van Museum).

The office was founded in 1994 by Carlo Cappai and Maria Alessandra Segantini and is based in Treviso and London.

Cappai and Segantini were educated at IUAV, University of Architecture of Venice, where they received an Awarded Master Degree in Architecture.

They have taught and lectured internationally in several universities and institutions among which are the MIT, Cambridge, USA, Syracuse University, School of Architecture, New York, Columbia GSAPP, the Museum of Modern Art in New York.

C+S werd bekroond met de 'Gold Medal Italian Architecture' voor hun 'urban adaptor' in Piazzale Roma in Venetië, met de In/Opera Award, de Sfide 2009 Prijs van het Italiaanse Ministerie van Milieu en de Gold Medal Italian Architecture Education voor hun voortreffelijke ontwerpen van schoolgebouwen. C+S werd internationaal gepubliceerd in architectuurboeken en magazines en stelde haar werk tentoon in het MIT in Boston, in Venetië (8^{ste}, 12de, 13de en 14de Architectuurbiënnale en 50^{ste} Kunstbiënnale), Milaan (op het Triënaal), Parijs (Cité de l'Architecture et du Patrimoine), Londen (RIBA), Barcelona (COAC), Wenen (Architektzentrum) en Leuven (M-Museum Leuven).

Het in Treviso en Londen gevestigde bureau werd in 1994 opgericht door Carlo Cappai en Maria Alessandra Segantini.

Cappai en Segantini volgden hun opleiding aan het IUAV, University of Architecture of Venice, waar ze een Awarded Master in Architecture behaalden.

Ze gaven internationaal lezingen aan het MIT in Boston, het Museum of Modern Art in New York, de Syracuse University en Columbia University GSAPP in New York.
